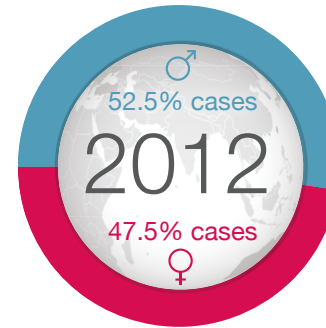


# TOP COMMON CANCERS AROUND THE WORLD

A visualization of worldwide cancer statistics in different regions around the world, with comparisons of incidence and mortality between men and women in these regions

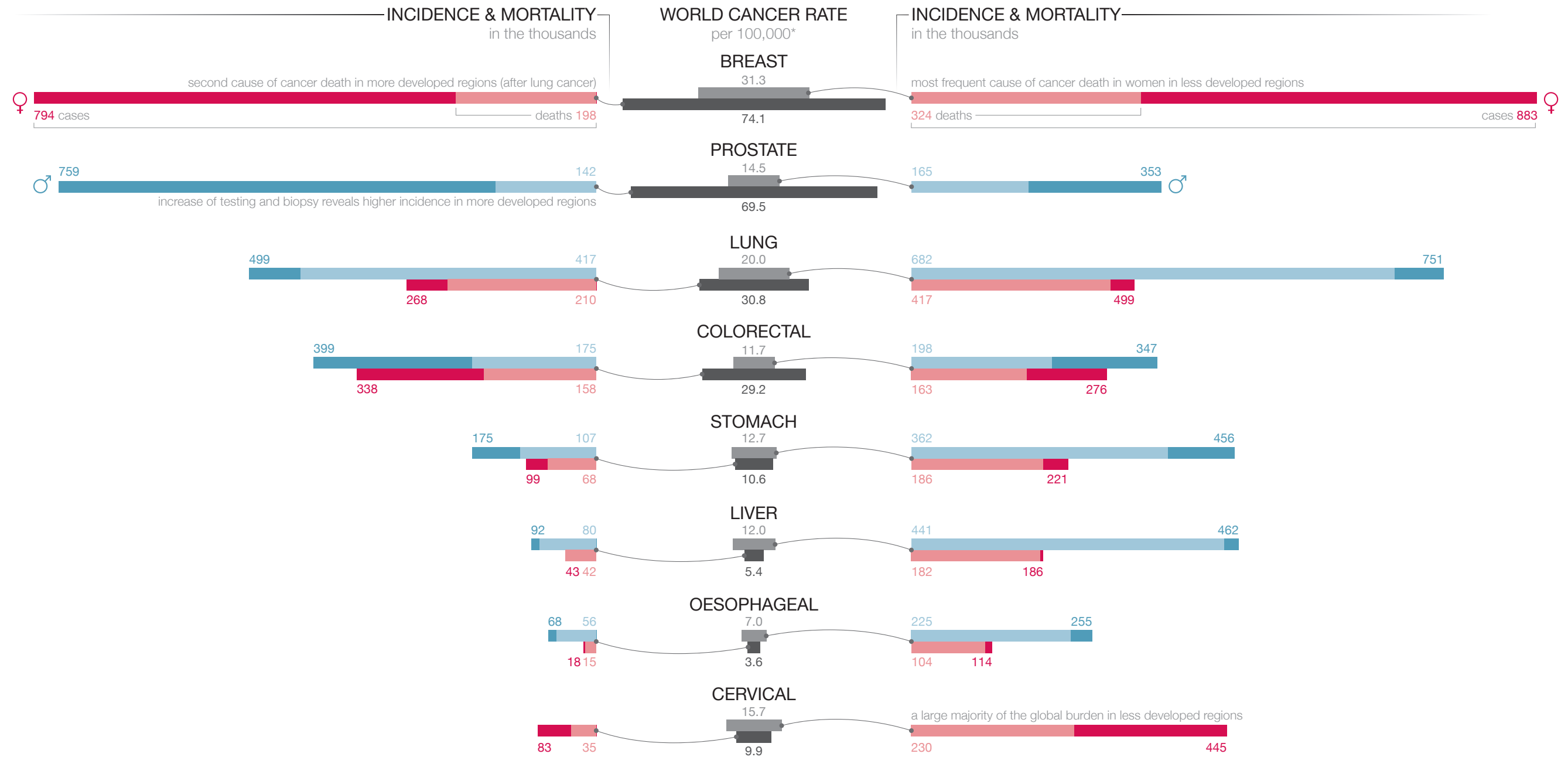
## MORE DEVELOPED REGIONS
